<u>The Award</u>: The Rising Star Alumna/us Award is awarded by the U.C. Davis School of Law Alumni Association Board of Directors to an alumna/us who has graduated in the past fifteen years and embodies the values of the School and has demonstrated early post-graduate achievement in the legal profession or in service to society or to the School.

<u>Eligibility</u>: Nominees must be graduates of the U.C. Davis School of Law within the past fifteen years. Nominees must have at least one recommendation describing the nominee's achievement or service. Nominations may be made by any member of the public.

<u>Selection Criteria</u>: Award recipients are selected on the basis of their early career achievements and service to society, such as contributions to the legal profession, education, public service, professional societies, and civic or community causes that reflect the values of the School and/or on the basis of their commitment to the School through their contributions of service or financial support to the School.
