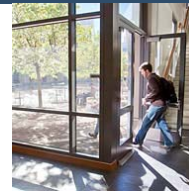

Federal Law Clerk Hiring for Post-Graduate Judicial Clerkships

The Ad Hoc Committee on Law Clerk Hiring led by Chief Judge Merrick Garland recently announced a two-year pilot federal law clerk hiring plan for post graduate clerkships. The following Circuits have signed on to the plan: DC Circuit, Second Circuit, Seventh Circuit, Ninth Circuit, and District of Connecticut. The plan provides that students in the class of 2020 will begin the federal law clerk application process starting **June 17, 2019**. Specifically, federal judges in the participating circuits will not seek or accept formal or informal clerkship applications, seek or accept formal or informal recommendations, conduct formal or informal interviews, or make formal or informal offers before the June 17, 2019 date.

Consequently, the Class of 2020 will gain access to OSCAR (the federal online system of clerkship application and review) on February 6, 2019 to register for an account, upload documents, search for federal clerkship positions, and build online applications. The system will store these applications and release them to judges on June 17, 2019.

UC Davis School of Law is committed to following this plan. As such, a revised clerkship application timeline is as follows:

Ongoing - Make an individual appointment with [Natalie Butcher](#) in Career Services to discuss your individual clerkship application strategy
February 6, 2019 - Register in OSCAR and search for federal clerkship positions
Spring 2019 - Draft application materials and seek review from Career Services, request letters of recommendation, prepare your applications
June 17, 2019 - Submit applications to federal judges in OSCAR

Nevada Supreme Court

Law clerks work for individual Justices and assist them with processing appeals and writ petitions. Most positions are located in Carson City, Nevada, with some positions located in Las Vegas, Nevada. Justice Kristina Pickering (King Hall '77) has hired numerous clerks from King Hall in the past.
