The San Francisco Trial Lawyers Association ("SFTLA") Diversity Committee has established a Fellowship Program to introduce a diverse group of law students to the plaintiffs' bar generally and to the SFTLA. The Fellowship Program (the "Program") will allow selected students to observe the work of trial attorneys as part of a summer-long mentoring program. Fellows will gain exposure to the work of trial attorneys by "shadowing" three mentor law firms, each for a three to four week period. Fellows will attend depositions, hearings, settlement proceedings, and possibly even trial with their mentors. They will also have the opportunity to work on short-duration projects, including a writing assignment.

Graduate law clerks assist attorneys with legal research and motion preparation, client interviews, assisting attorneys in trial, and other assorted tasks of value to the Department in fulfilling its mission to effectively represent our clients. If certified by the State Bar of California, graduate law clerks may be permitted to litigate motions in court under the supervision of the assigned attorney. Graduate law clerks earn \$19.59 per hour. The positions are filled for one year terms that begin in mid to late August. Applicants who qualify for an interview will be contacted to schedule an interview in November. Hiring decisions are completed by January.
