The Office of the Circuit Executive for the Ninth Circuit just posted two new summer externships in SF. These are NOT externships with a judge, but rather externships with the Office of the Circuit Executive working on either internal legal affairs of the Circuit (including the judicial misconduct complaint process) or on policies relating to how the Circuit handles prisoner and pro se litigation.

Legal Affairs Externship: Under the supervision of the Assistant Circuit Executive for Legal Affairs and/or Research Attorney, the incumbent will conduct research, prepare legal memoranda, and provide assistance to the Legal Affairs Unit, including projects related to the judicial misconduct complaint process.
