Symplicity Tip - How to Create and Upload Unofficial Transcripts

Law School Transcripts

Copy your transcript from SIS Web and paste it into a Word document; clean the appearance of the transcript and be sure your name is at the top of the document. Next save the document as a .pdf file and upload it to Symplicity by selecting *Unofficial Transcript* in your *Documents* section.

Non-Law School Transcripts

Some employers request an undergraduate transcript as part of your application. Create an undergrad unofficial transcript on a Word document. Upload to Symplicity by selecting *Other Document* in your *Documents* section.

NOTE: Symplicity only allows one transcript at a time to be labeled as *Unofficial Transcript* and that will be your law school transcript. Undergrad transcripts will be labeled as *Other Document*. However, if an employer also has another document listed as “Other Document” in their posting, in addition to undergrad transcripts, then you can create one transcript document that includes both your law school and undergrad transcripts and label that as *Unofficial Transcript*.
