## Everything You Need to Know About Government Honors Attorney Programs

**For the Class of 2017:**

Entry-level attorney positions in government (the federal government especially) can be tough to come by. One major exception: government honors programs. Each year, many government departments recruit and hire for a limited number of openings reserved for recent graduates. Competition for these programs is often intense, but grades are only one part of what the agencies usually look for. Commitment to working in government, subject-matter expertise and/or experience, and long-term potential are all important factors, so everyone interested is encouraged to apply.

Hiring for government honors positions varies by agency, but are frequently quite early. Some deadlines have passed already, but many others are yet to come. We strongly encourage students to peruse honors program listings ASAP, so you don't miss out on great opportunities! It's easy. American Society of International Law Job Board

King Hall students have free access to American Society of International Law's (ASIL) job board website as part of UC Davis School of Law's ASIL membership. The job board is a great tool to find jobs and internships related to international law that are located in various places around the world as well as in the U.S. and even California!

However, you may run into issues when registering if you follow the website's procedures. Here are instructions to register so that you do not end up paying for this free resource.

To enjoy free access to ASIL's job board:

1. Go to ASIL's membership page: <https://www.asil.org/membership/membership>.
2. Fill out the form, and make sure to **register with your UC Davis email (@ucdavis.edu) as your preferred email address on the registration form**. You must register with your UC Davis email to access the job board for free.
3. Complete the form and click Submit.
4. Once you reach the page that asks you to select a type of membership, **exit**. You do not need to continue on in registration to access the job board. The membership page is for those seeking individual membership, which is not free and not required to read job and internship postings on the website.
5. After exiting, go to <https://www.asil.org/job-board>. On that page, enter your username and password in the section located near the upper-right corner of the page next to the "Log in" button.

After logging in, explore away! Check the job board website often as new postings are frequent.
