#### STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

The Alternate Budget appeal is available to students that meet one of the scenarios outlined below:

- 1) Single student with 1 or more children age 18 and under
- 2) Married student with 1 or more children age 18 and under
- 3) Married student with no children and a spouse not enrolled at least half-time in college or employed

#### **FUNDING**

We will fund approved budget increases with Direct Unsubsidized Loan up to annual maximum of \$20,500 and Direct Graduate Plus Loan up to the increased cost of attendance.

#### 2020-2021 STANDARD NINE-MONTH BUDGET ALLOWANCE FOR HOUSING, FOOD AND PERSONAL

Housing:	_\$8,493 per academic year (\$4,246 per semester)
Food:	\$4,905 per academic year (\$2,452 per semester)

	Recreation and incidentals (\$569)

#### HOW DO YOU CALCULATE THE ALTERNATIVE BUDGET?

#### For single or married students with children

We will add one-third more of the <u>annual</u> housing and food allowances. In addition, we will add one-third of the <u>annual</u> adjusted personal allowance (standard allowance minus medical/dental/optical) for each dependent. This adjustment is for the **nine-month** academic year.

#### For married students with no children and a spouse not enrolled at least half-time in college or employed

We will add one-third more of the <u>semester</u> housing and food allowances. In addition, we will add one-third of the <u>semester</u> adjusted personal allowance (standard allowance minus medical/dental/optical). This adjustment is for **one semester**.

#### SAMPLE CALCULATION OF ADDITIONAL ALLOWANCE FOR SINGLE OR MARRIED STUDENT WITH ONE DEPENDENT:

Total:	\$4,918 for the nine-month academic year
Personal:	\$452 for each dependent
Food:	\$1,635 per academic year
Housing:	\$2,831 per academic year
