To apply for Federal Work-Study at UC Davis School of Law students must:

1. File the 2021-2022 and 2022-2023 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov. *Parent information is required on the FAFSA application even if you claim independent status, unless you meet one of the exception criteria listed at <https://law.ucdavis.edu/financial-aid/prospective/applying-for-aid.html>.*
2. Submit the work-study application located at <https://law.ucdavis.edu/financial-aid/current/work-study.html> to the Law Financial Aid Office on or before **April 22, 2022**.

What is Federal Work-Study?

Work-study allows a student to earn financial aid through employment. Instead of a financial aid payment, the student's work-study award is paid in the form of a payroll check for hours worked.

Employer Information

The employer must be a non-profit organization or a government agency, and the work performed must be in the public interest. The organization must offer work-study pay. Inquire with the organization as work-study pay is sometimes available when the positions are listed as *unpaid*. The organization must also enter into a Work-Study Program Agreement with UC Davis. The agreement requires approval by UC Campus Counsel, which takes time, so it is important to start the program agreement process as soon as possible.

Did You Know?

Summer work-study allotments are part of your spring semester 2022 and fall semester 2022 academic year financial aid awards. As your total financial aid award is limited to the cost of attendance for the academic year, using your work-study in the summer *will decrease the amount of federal loans available to you during the academic year*. You can mitigate the impact of this decrease if you carefully budget your academic year financial aid, but you must think about this in advance and determine if you wish to accept this arrangement.
